3. Peneh beras-beras – This is a cloth/ design is inspired from a decorative backdrop, "beras," made of strips of bamboo or rattan, painted with intricate geometric designs, common among the rich Yakan. In the past, this was referred to as "pallipattang."

4. Peneh dawen-dawen - This is a cloth/ design inspired by the "leaves."

5. Peneh kabban buddi – This cloth/ design is inspired from patchwork decorations done on canopies, mattresses, and sometimes pillow cases. Patterning may be single diamond or "dambuwah kabban buddi," and the "ampat kabban buddi," four diamonds within a diamond.

8. Peneh kule-kule - This cloth/ design is inspired from the tortoise/ turtle.

9. Peneh Pitumpuh/ bunga sama teed peneh pitumpuh – This is a cloth/ design with the most intricate patterning in the bunga category. There are 70 designs which are often made up of seven colors, reminiscent of the "birarali (var. bidadali or biradali)," or rainbow and the colorful wings of the mythical seven sky maidens or daughters of the rainbow.

10. Peneh sawe-sawe – This is a cloth/ design inspired by the designs on the back of a "snake."





11. Peneh sumping-sumping – This is a cloth/ design inspired by the shape of the petals of a "flower."

- B. SINALU'AN This is a design/ cloth/ category of weave with stripes of the diamond twill technique.
- 1. Adjayit/ Adjayip This cloth/ design is utilized for blouse (for men only) and trouser material, but the patterned stripe has just the triangles, and not the intricate pattern.





2. Binengkettan – This cloth/ design is utilized for blouse (for men only) and trouser material, but the patterned stripes have only a combination of incised triangles and diamonds, literally "binengket" or "bengket," "lifted from" the original "sinaluan" pattern.




3. Sinelu'an Teed – This is a cloth/ design utilized for blouse (for men only) and trouser material; a type of weaving with vertical stripes; the most intricate of all Yakan woven textiles. Each of the stripes has an elaborate pattern of miniscule diamonds and incised triangles resembling the sections of the bamboo.

C. Pagal Batu - This is a cloth/ pattern utilized only as blouse material for both sexes; literally "mirrored" patterning.



D. Inalaman – This consists of squares made up of four triangles or diamonds called "kabban buddi." The weaving technique is similar to the "bunga" category.

E. Palantup/ pinalantup/ pinalantupan/ pinentupan – This is a cloth/ pattern utilized only on skirts/ overpants.

F. Saputangan/ Seputangan

A meter square in size with geometric design is the most expensive part of the female costume due to the intricacy of its design. This piece of cloth is folded and tied over the olos to tighten the hold of the skirt on the



waist. It may also be worn as a head covering. It is also placed on the shoulders of brides and grooms during weddings.

G. Pis – a square cloth of about one meter on all sides, handwoven red cloth with stripes of yellow, green, and black; traditionally used as head cloth by the men.
