- . All materials, equipment, labor, tools, and consumables necessary for project completion shall be included



- . All installations shall comply with applicable electrical, safety, ICT, and building standards

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR BIDDERS:

1. Bidding papers may be acquired starting July 25 to August 20, 2026, from the BAC Office or download from agency website (www.wmsu.edu.ph) and PhilGEPS website. The WESTERN MINDANAO STATE UNIVERSITY shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the Bidding Documents fees before the submission of their bids, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php.50,000.00). (Please attached the machine copy of the Official Receipt)
2. All bidders are required to post a Bid Security, at least Two (2%) Percent of the ABC in the form of Cash, Cashier's Check or Manager's Check or may submit Bid Securing Declaration. Bids without Bid Security will not be considered.
3. The Bidder shall prepare an original of the Eligibility Documents & Technical Components and original of Financial Proposal and clearly mark each "ORIGINAL – ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS and TECHNICAL COMPONENTS", and "ORIGINAL – FINANCIAL PROPOSAL", respectively. Bidders shall submit one (1) set of the first and second components of its bid. State the unit price of each item and the total bid price and also state the shortest time of delivery and submit your proposal duly signed by your representative in a sealed envelope. Failure to submit any of the eligibility documents, technical components and financial proposal during bid opening will result in disqualification.
4. Pre-Bid Conference will be on August 6, 2026 9:30 AM at Procurement Conference Office, Ground Floor Administration Building, WMSU, Zamboanga City and/or through video conferencing or webcasting via Zoom, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
5. Bid Submission will be on or before August 20, 2026 9:30 AM. through Manual Submission.
6. Bid opening shall be on August 20, 2026 9:30 AM. at Procurement Conference Office, Ground Floor Administration Building, WMSU, Zamboanga City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders representatives who choose to attend at the address above. Late bids shall not be accepted.
7. The contract will be awarded to the bidder who submits the Most Economically Advantageous Responsive Bid (MEARB)
8. Price validity shall be for a period of 120 calendar days.
9. Bidders shall submit original brochures showing certifications of the product being offered.
10. Warranty shall be for a period of Six (6) months for supplies and materials. One (1) year for equipment, from date of acceptance by WESTERN MINDANAO STATE UNIVERSITY.
11. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid Opening.
